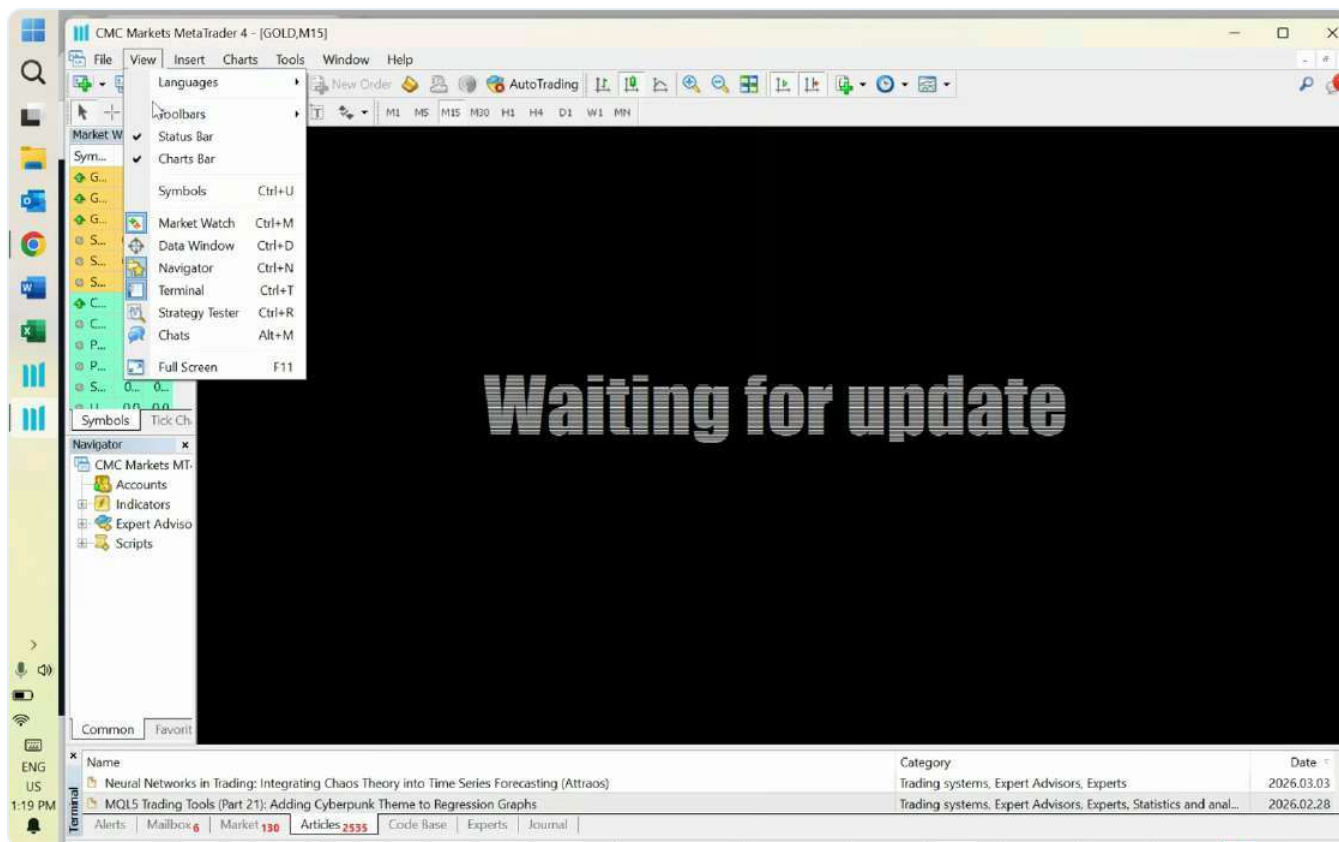


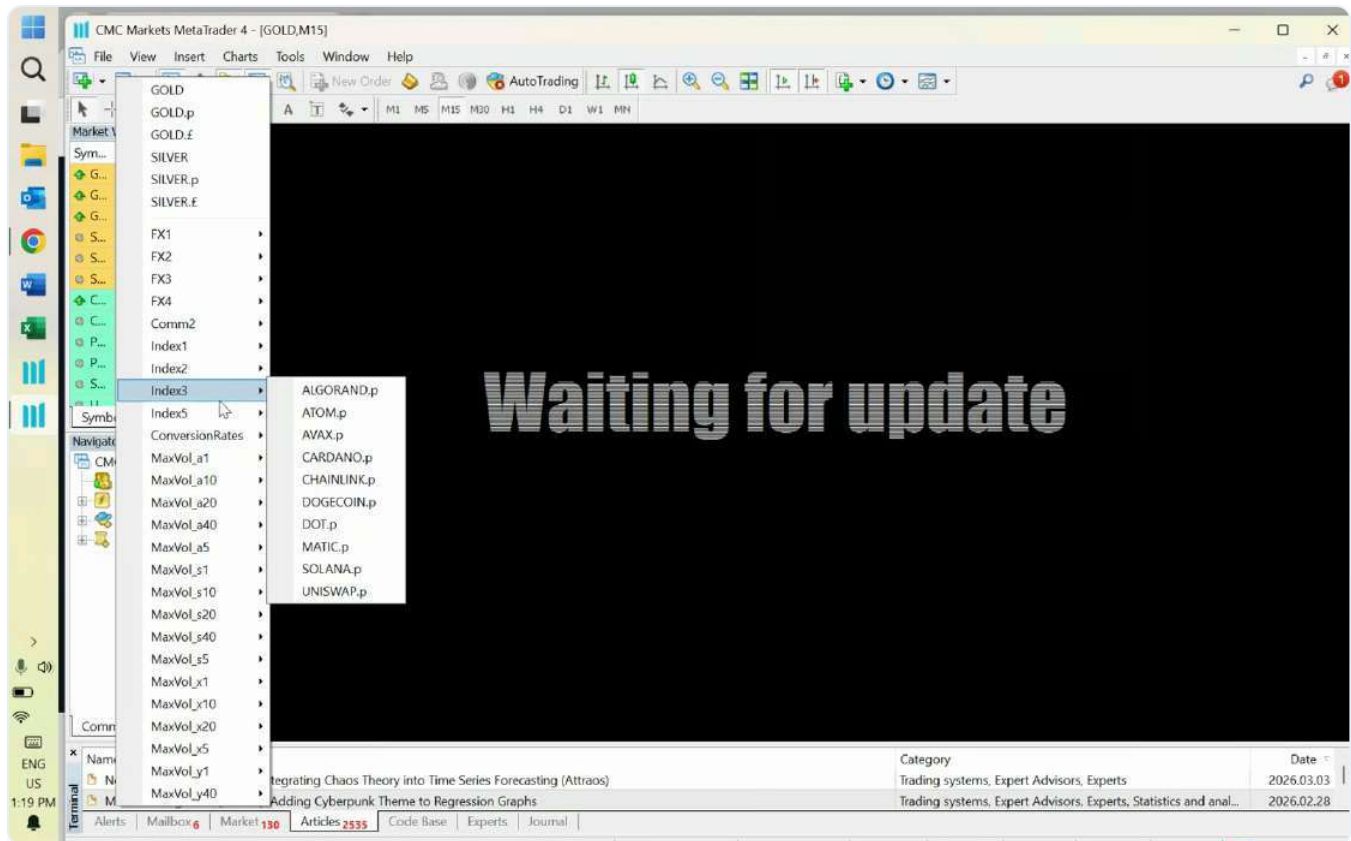
20 Click File, then New Chart

Open a new chart if needed.



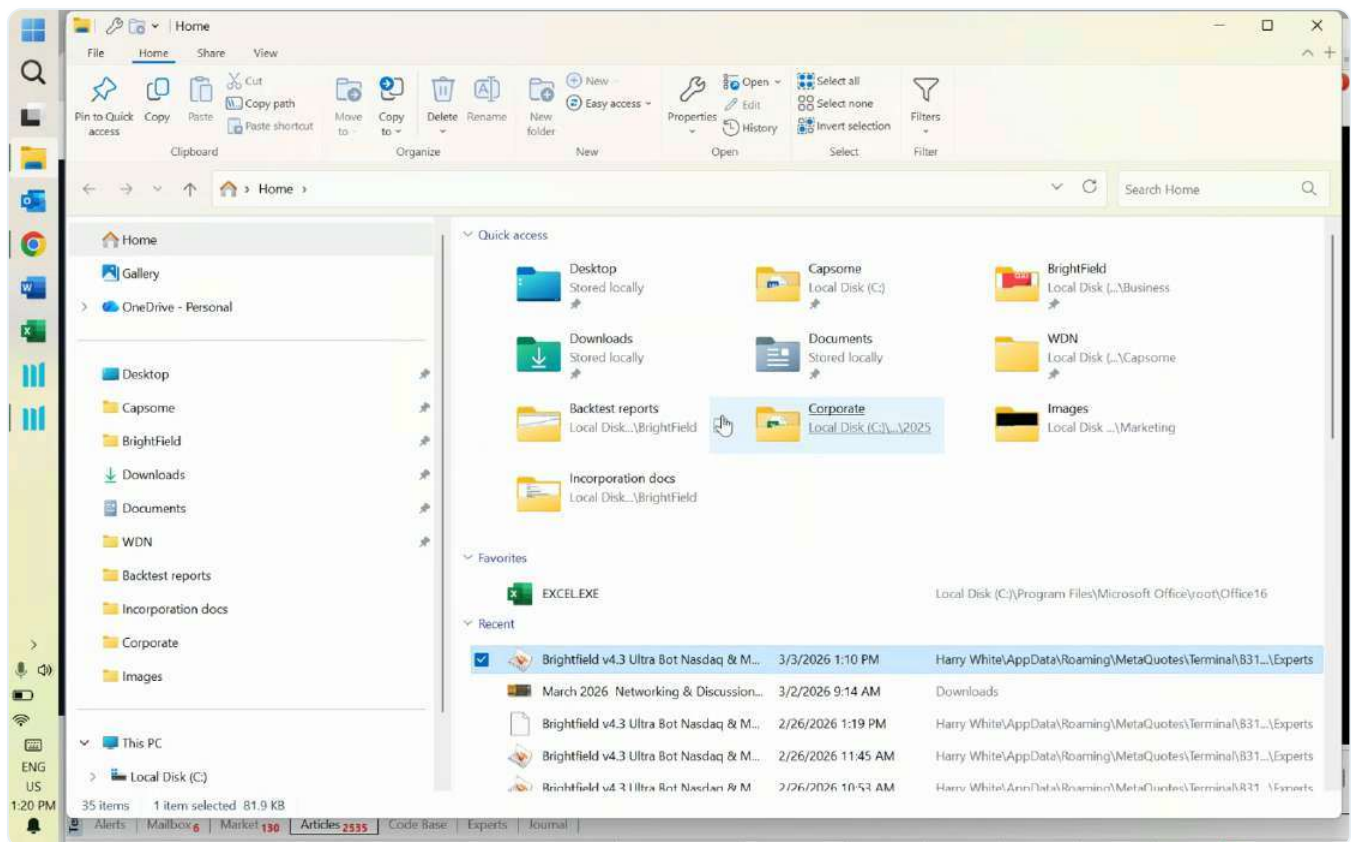
21 Scroll down and look for the NASDAQ 100

Find the NASDAQ 100 instrument in the list.



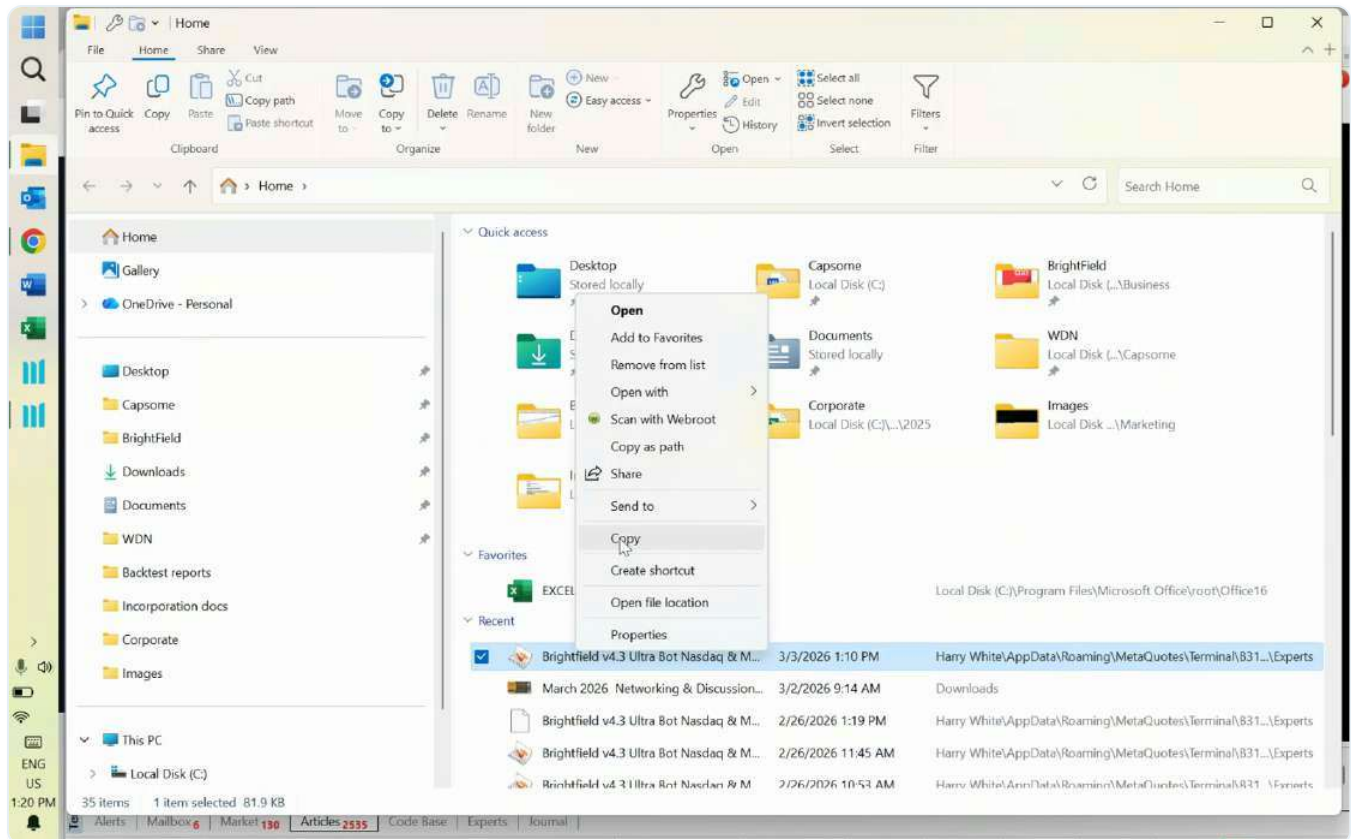
22 Copy the downloaded MetaTrader bot file

Prepare the bot file for installation.



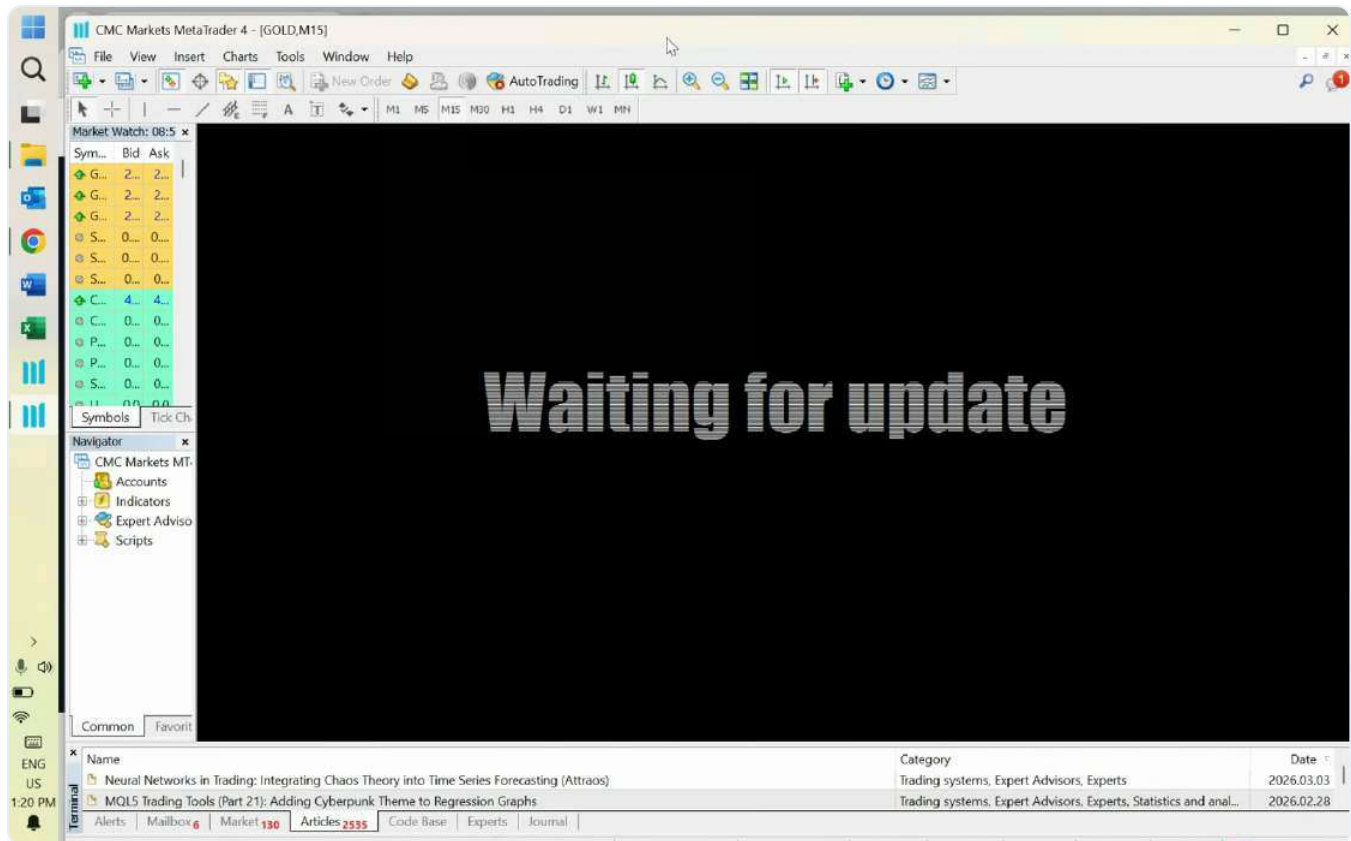
23 Right click and select Copy on the bot file

Copy the bot file to your clipboard.



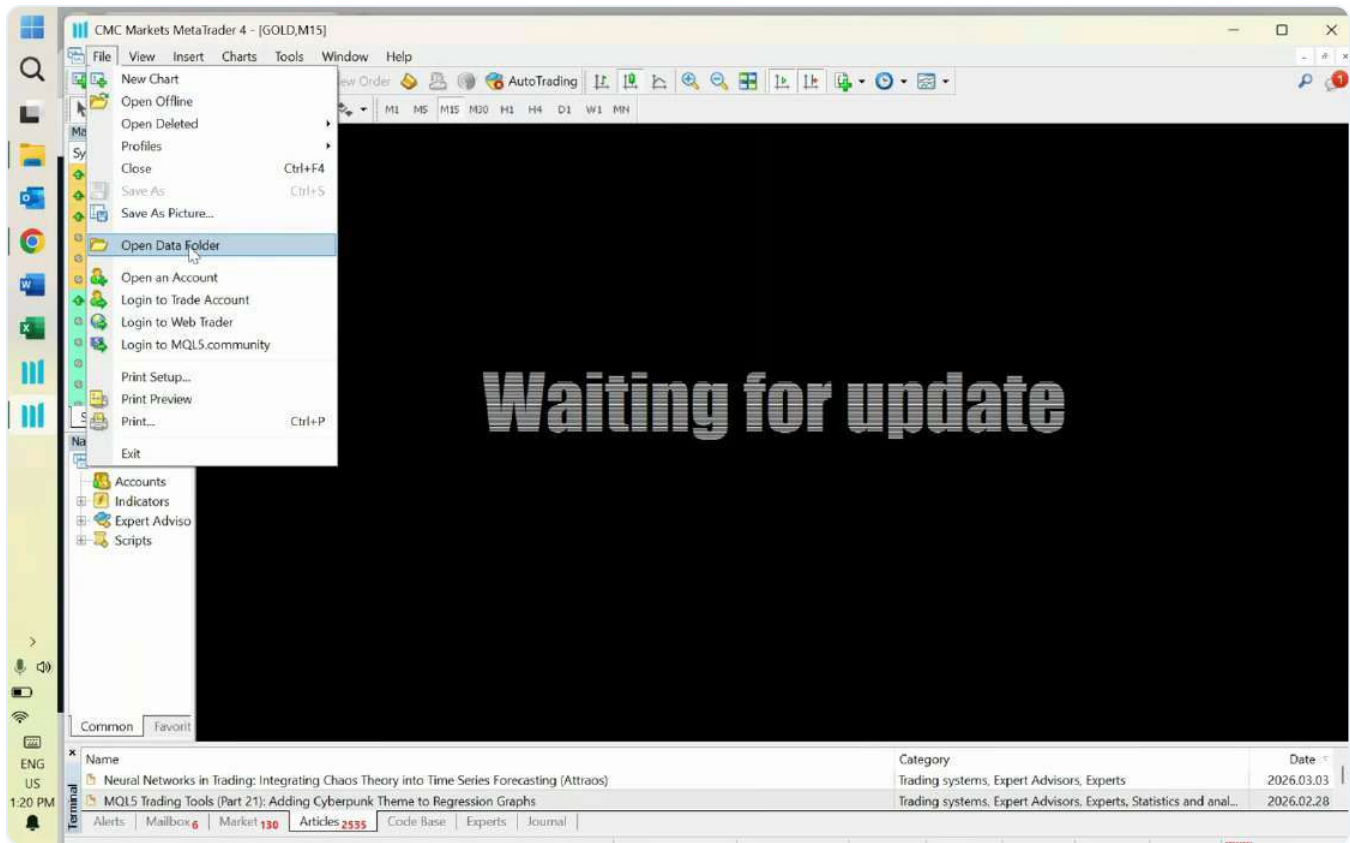
24 Go back into your CMC MetaTrader 4 app

Switch to the MetaTrader 4 application.



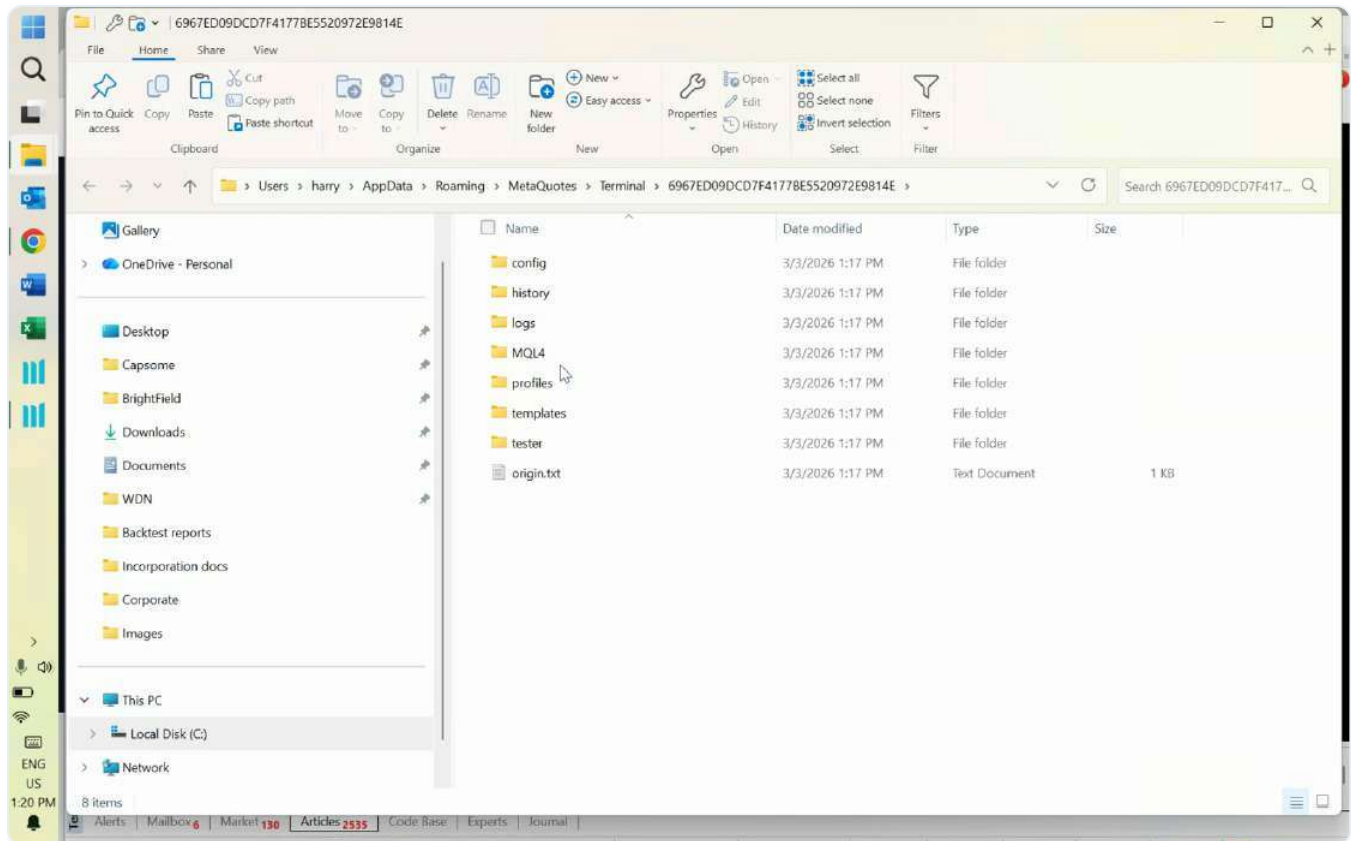
25 Click File, then Open Data Folder

Access the folder where MetaTrader stores its files.



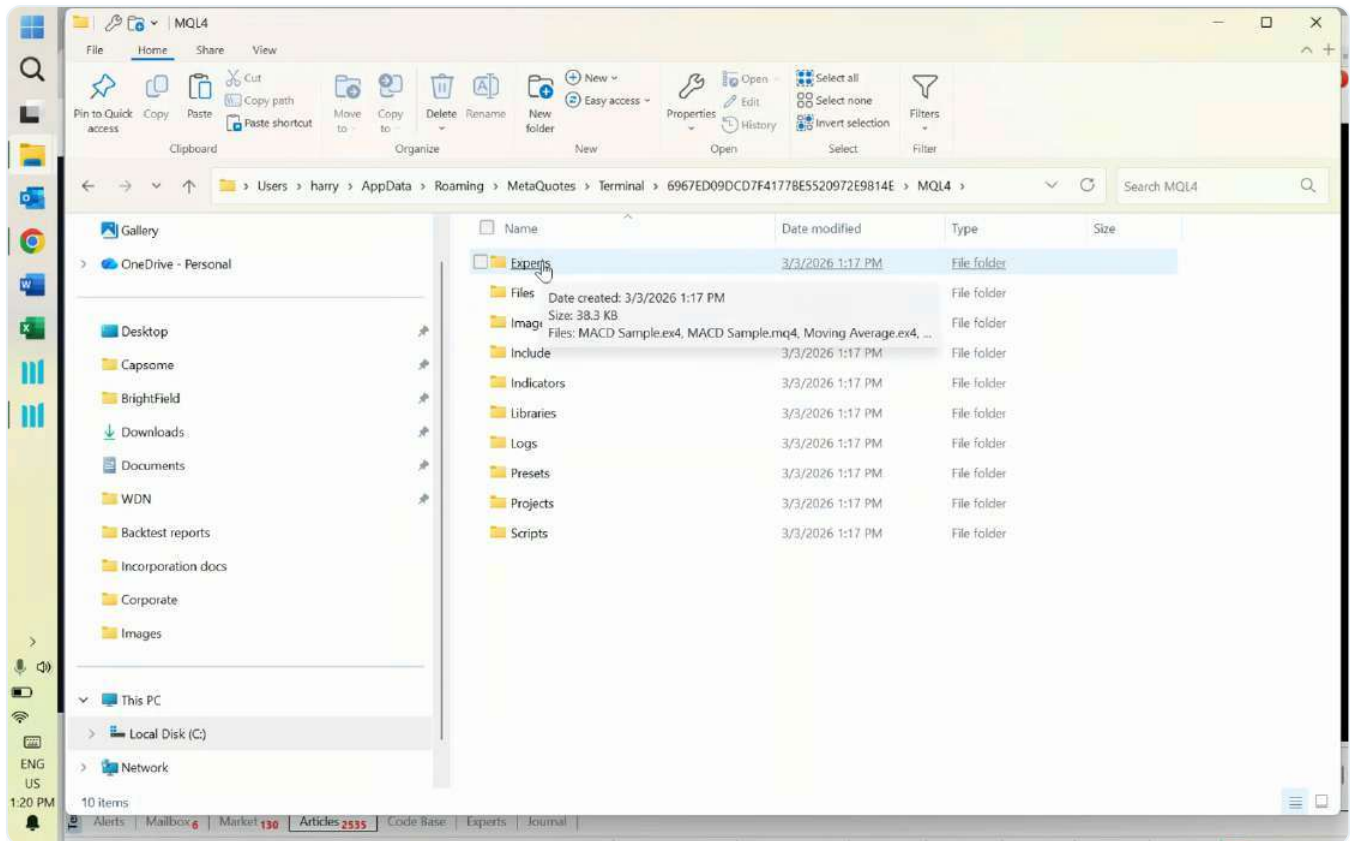
26 Click MQL4 folder

Navigate to the MQL4 directory.



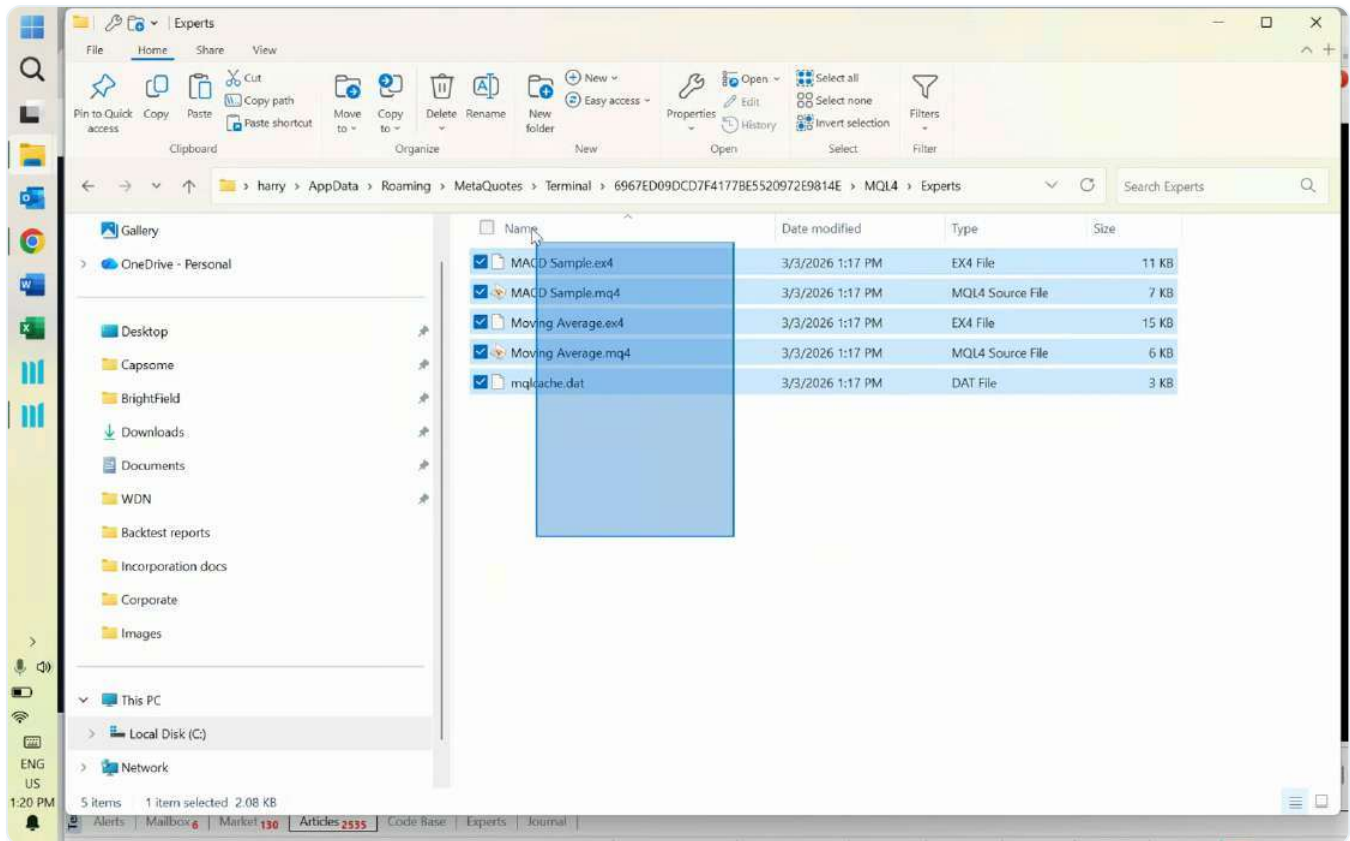
27 Click Experts folder

Open the Experts folder to add your bot.



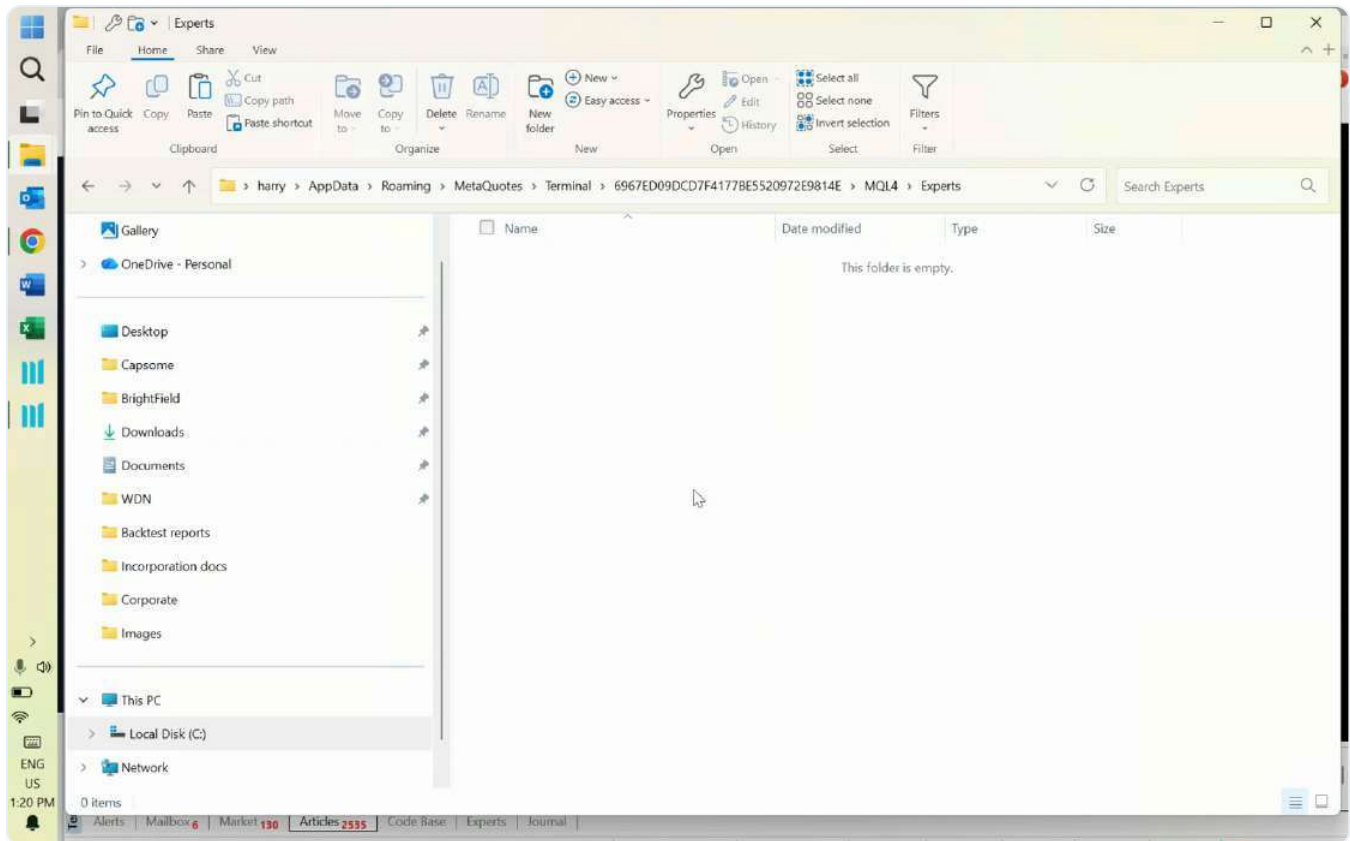
28 Delete any existing files in the Experts folder

Remove old bots or scripts to avoid conflicts.



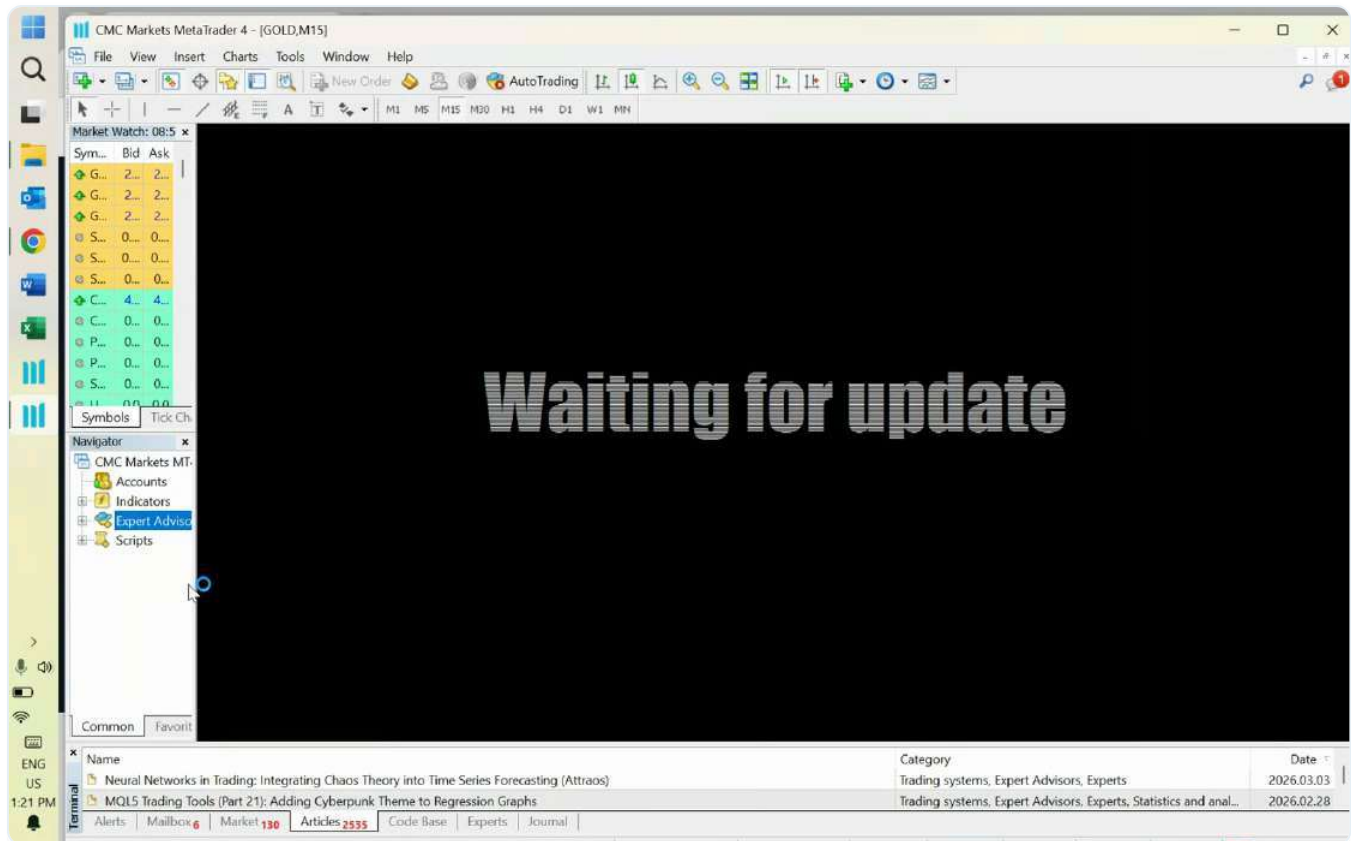
29 Right click and paste the Brightfield bot into the Experts folder

Add your new trading bot to MetaTrader.



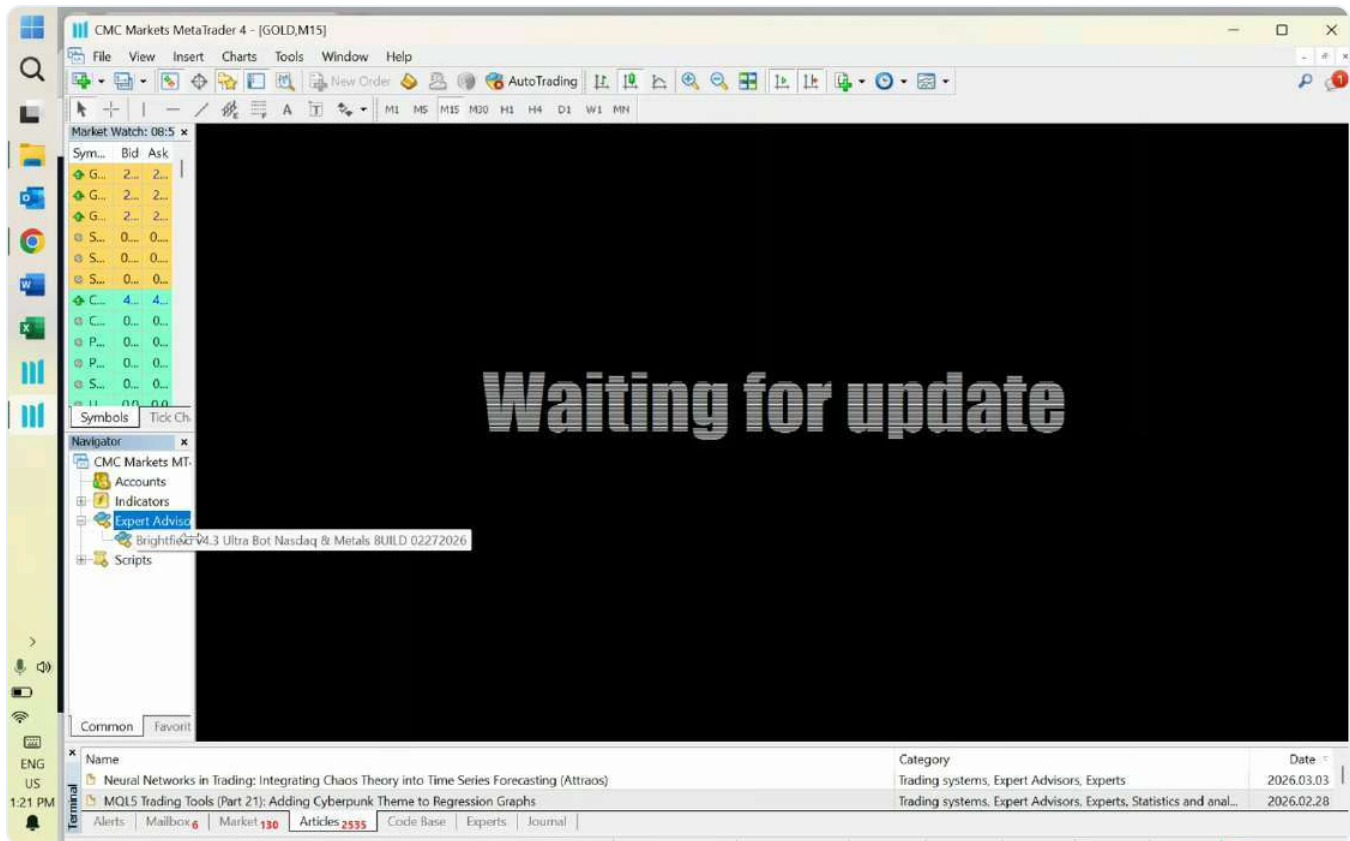
30 Right click on Expert Advisors and click Refresh

Refresh the list so your new bot appears.



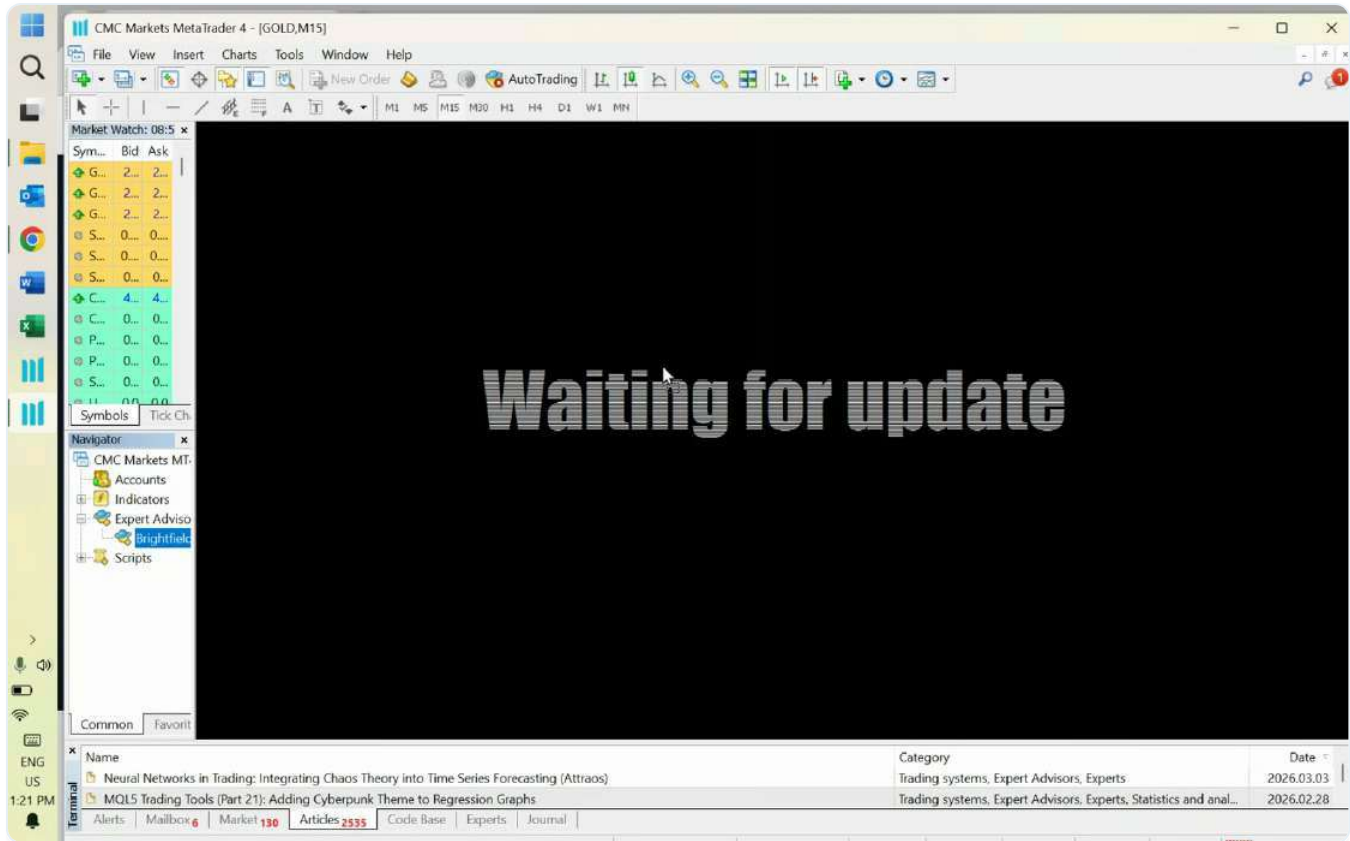
31 Verify the Brightfield bot is showing up

Ensure your bot is now available in MetaTrader.



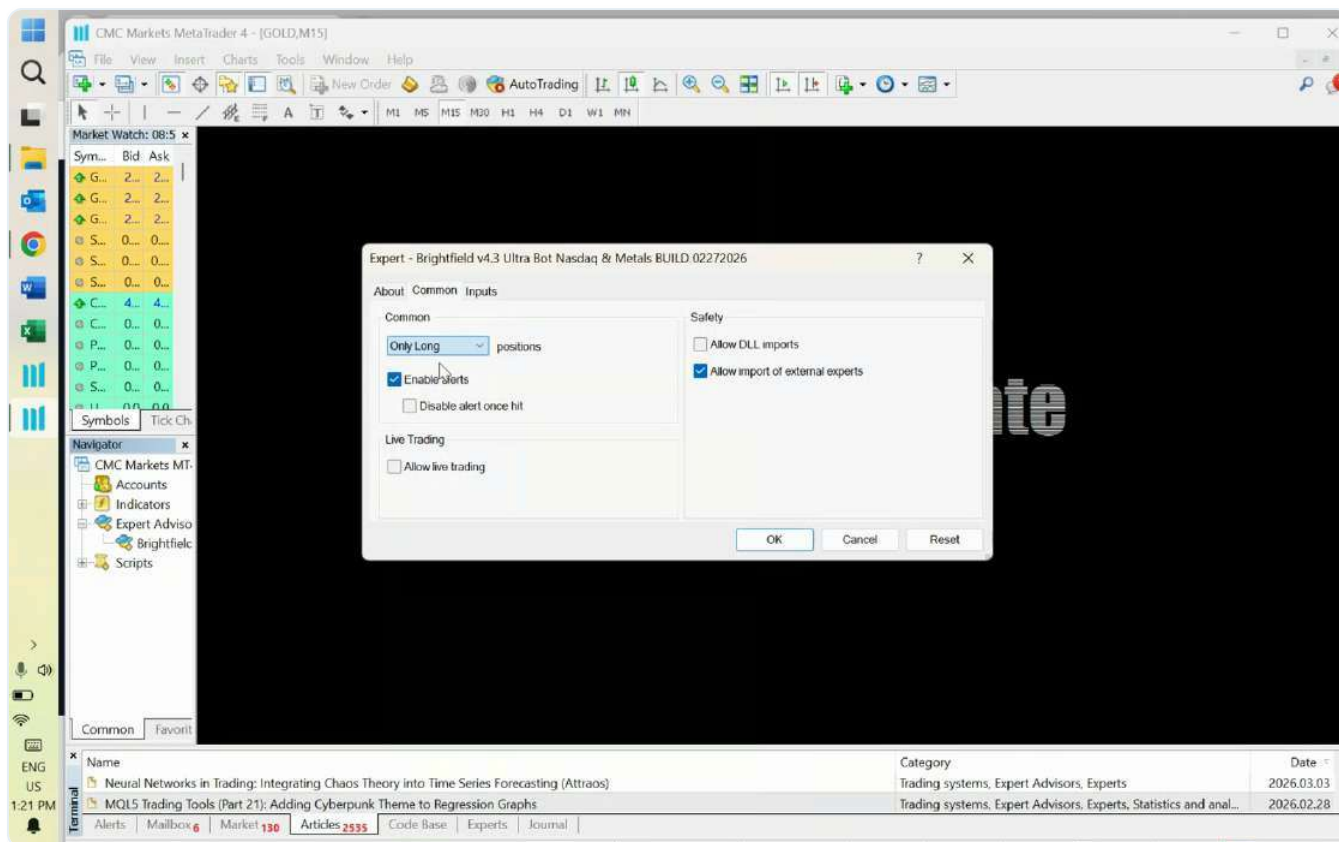
32 Right click and drag the Brightfield bot onto the gold, NASDAQ, or silver chart

Apply the bot to your chosen instrument.



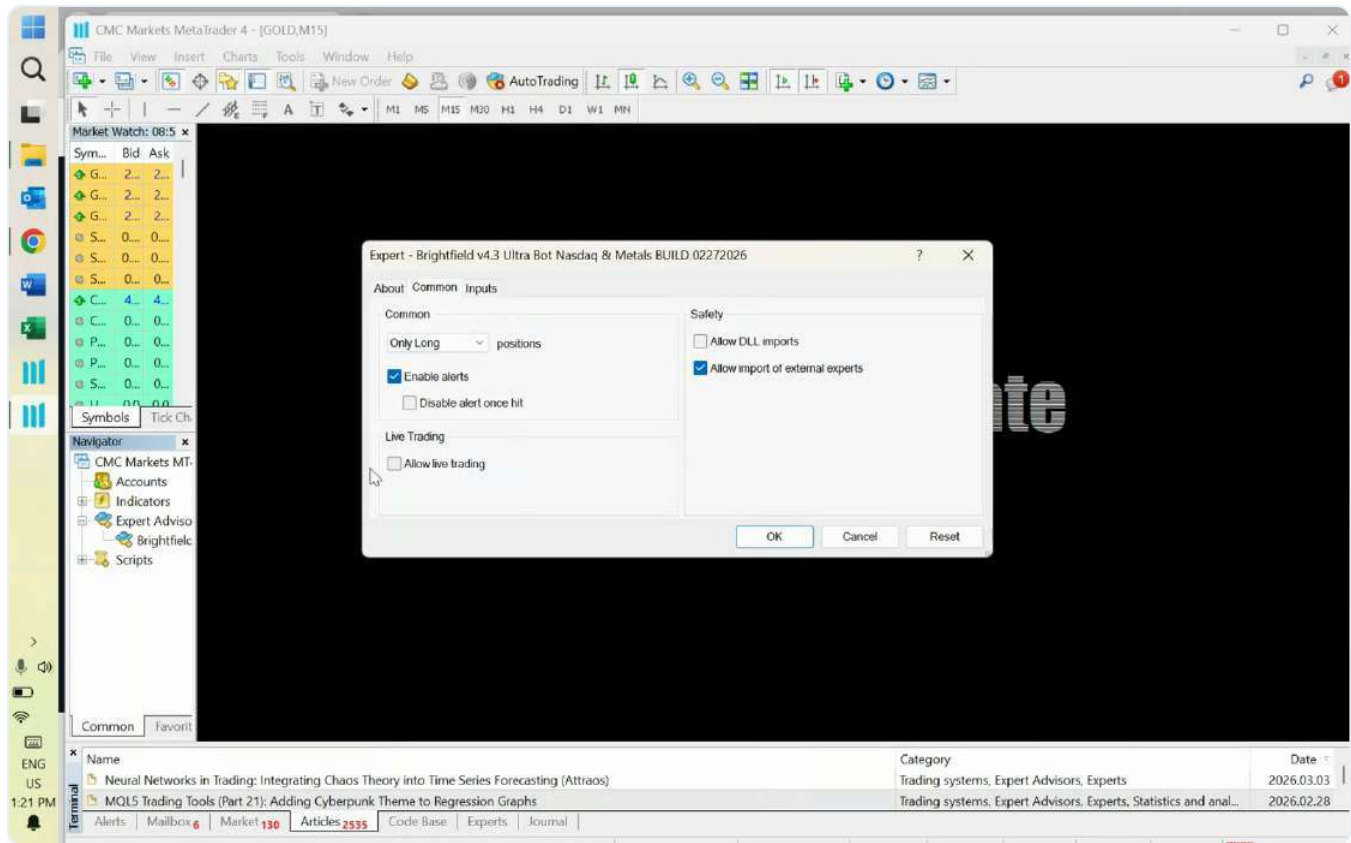
33 Under Common, click Only Long

Set the bot to only take long trades.



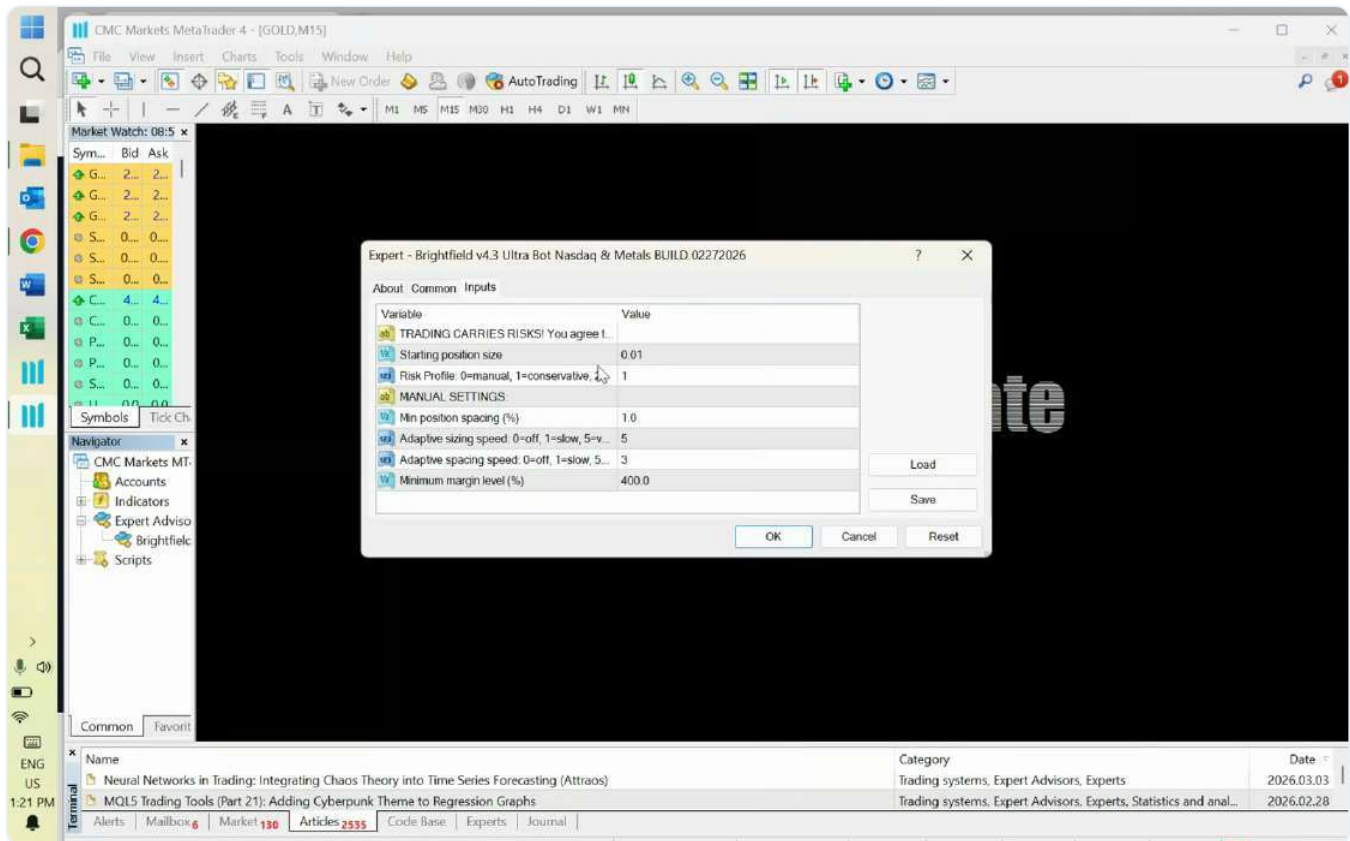
34 Click Allow Live Trading

Enable live trading for the bot.



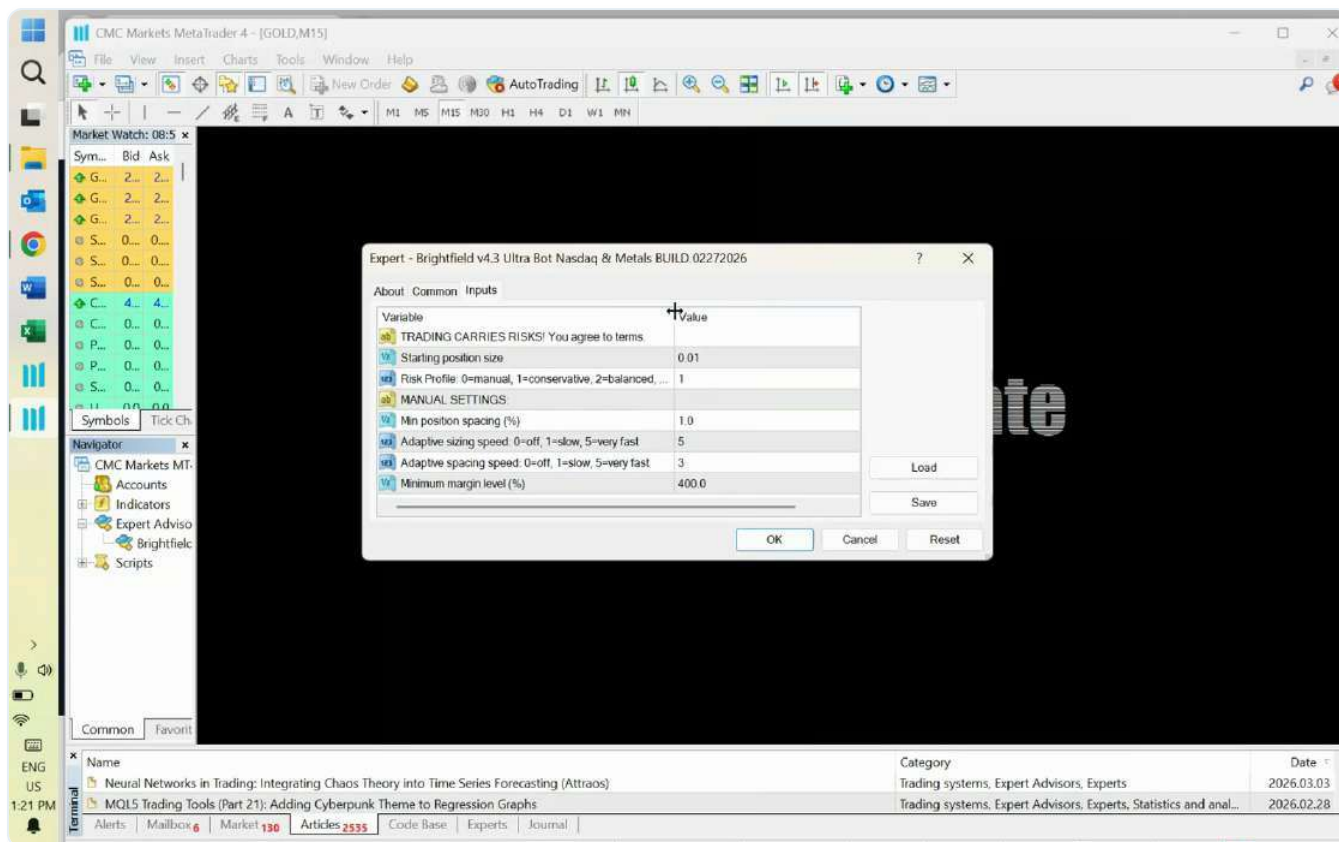
35 Select your starting position size

Choose the lot size for your trades.



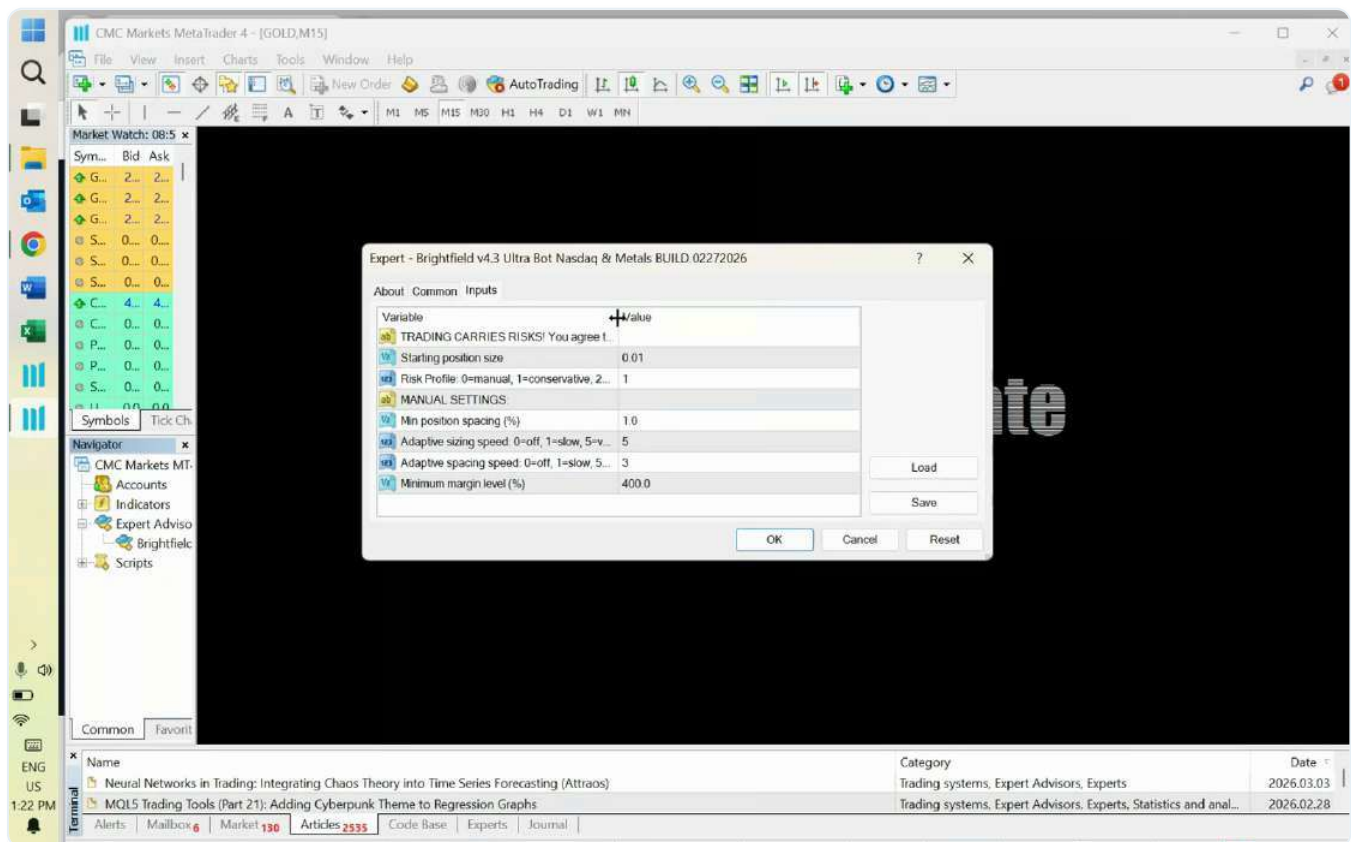
36 Set your risk profile using the presets or manual settings

Configure the bot's risk management.



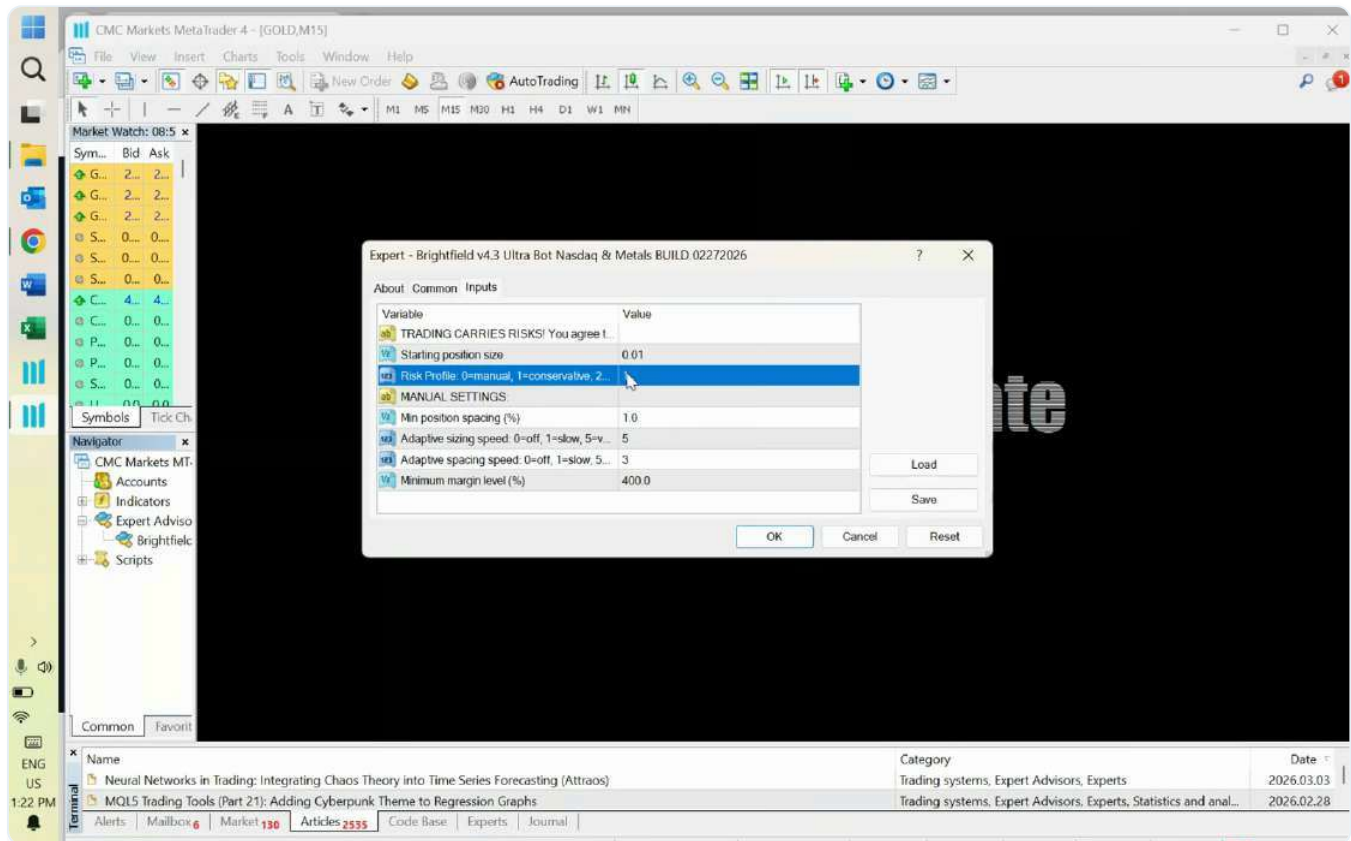
37 Select 0 for manual, 1 for conservative, 2 for balanced, or 3 for high risk

Choose the appropriate risk level for your trading style.



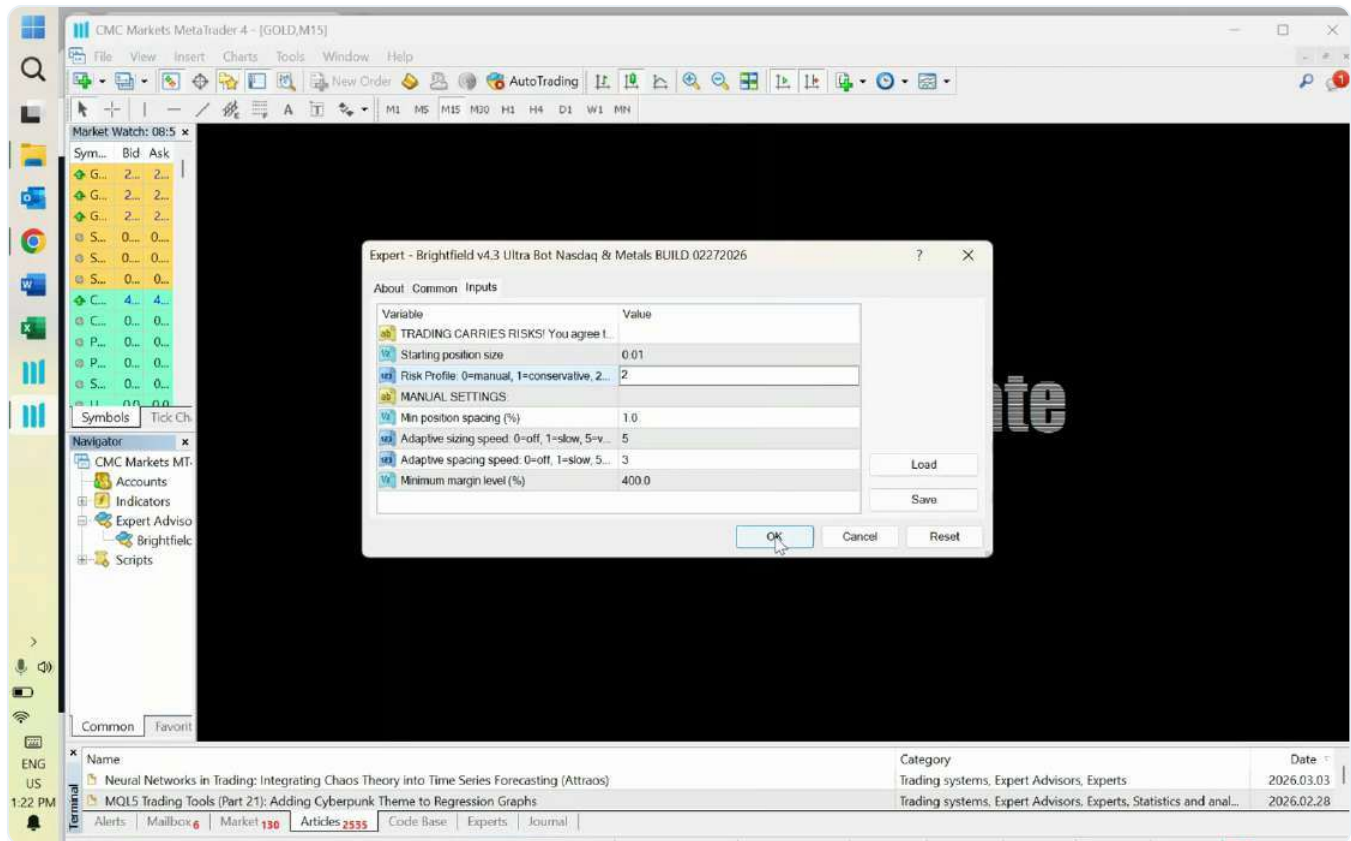
38 Enter the number corresponding to your risk profile

Input your risk selection in the settings.



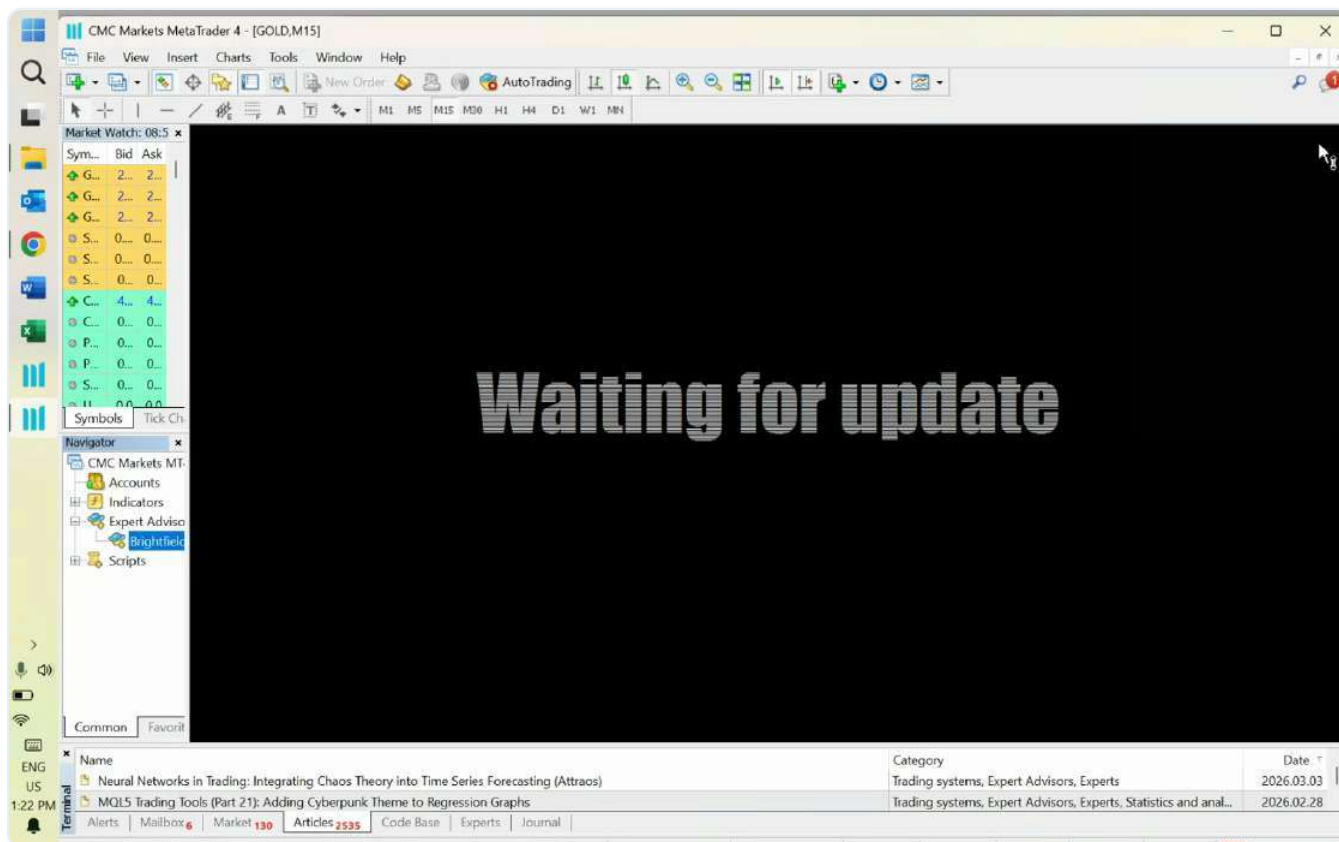
39 Click OK to apply the settings

Save your configuration and activate the bot.



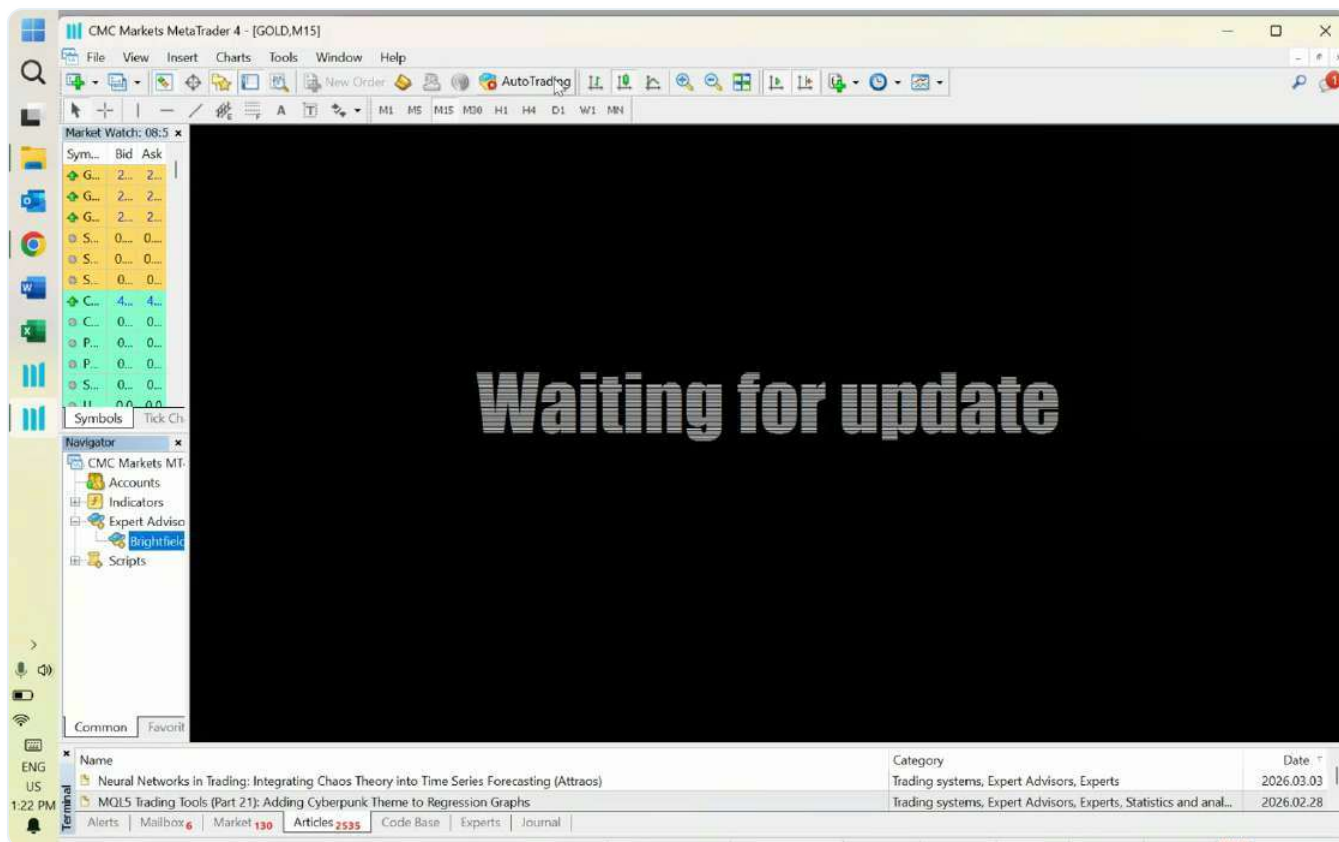
40 Check for a happy face icon in the top right to confirm the bot is active

A happy face indicates the bot is running.



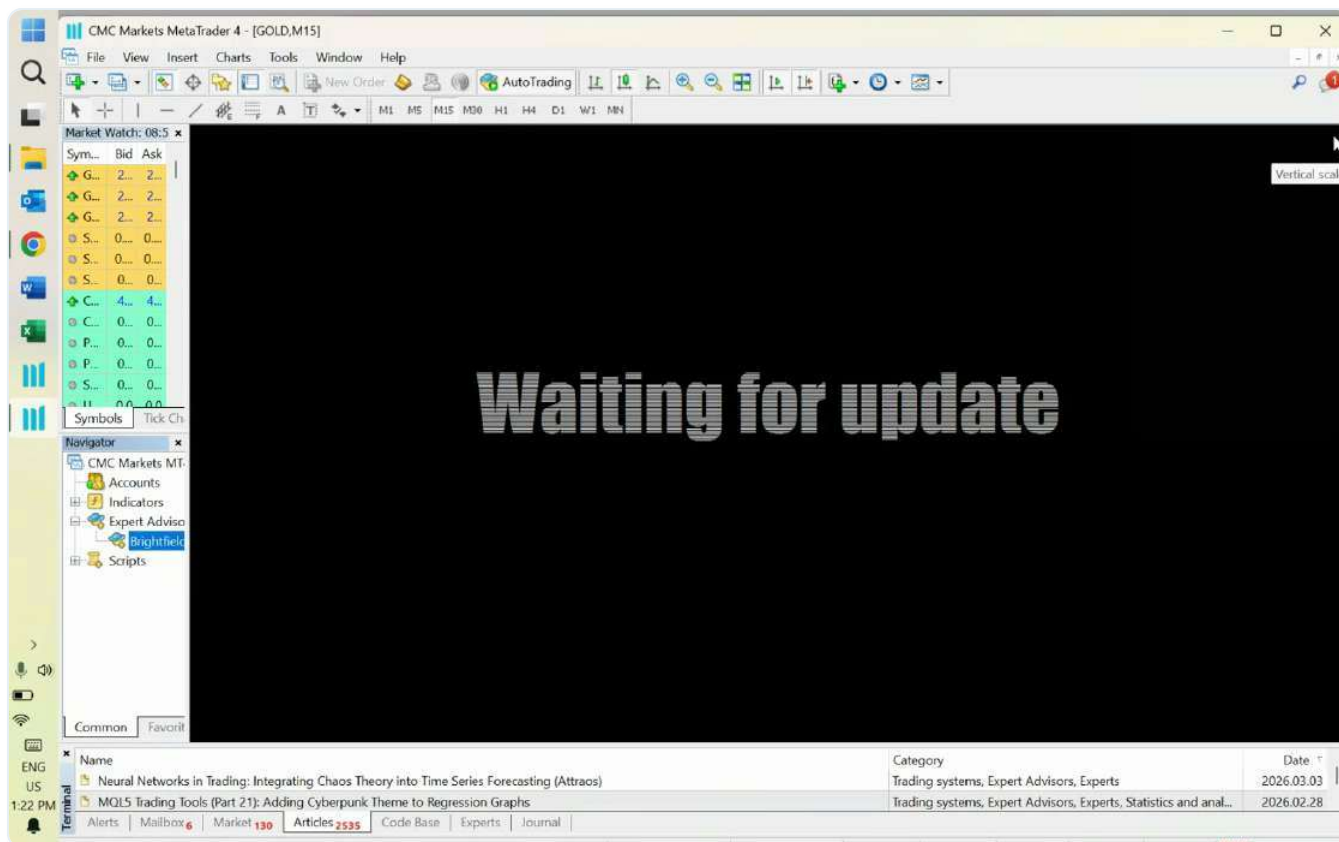
41 If you see a sad face, click Order Trading to enable trading

This should turn the icon into a happy face.



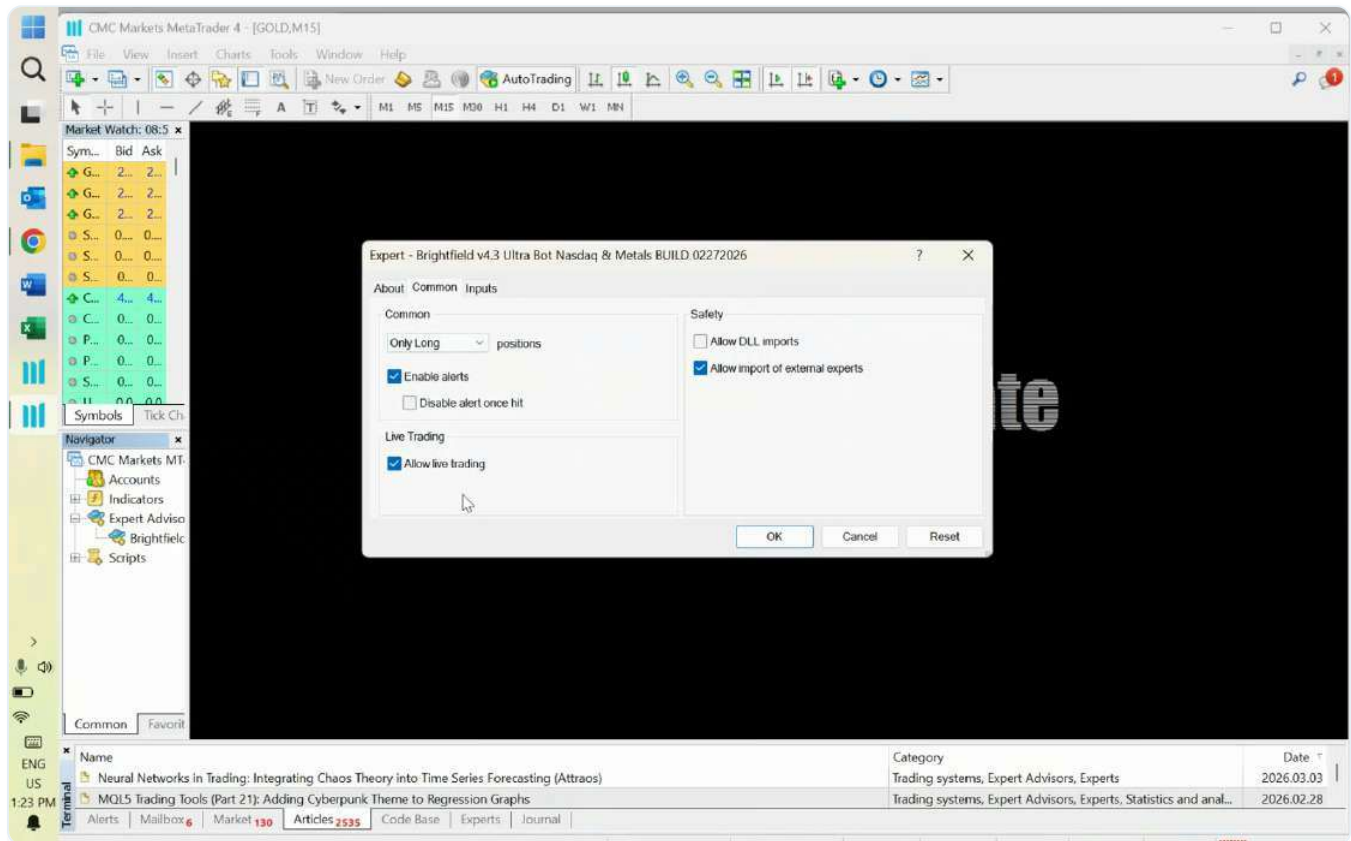
42 If it still isn't a happy face, right click on the happy face icon

Open the settings for the bot.



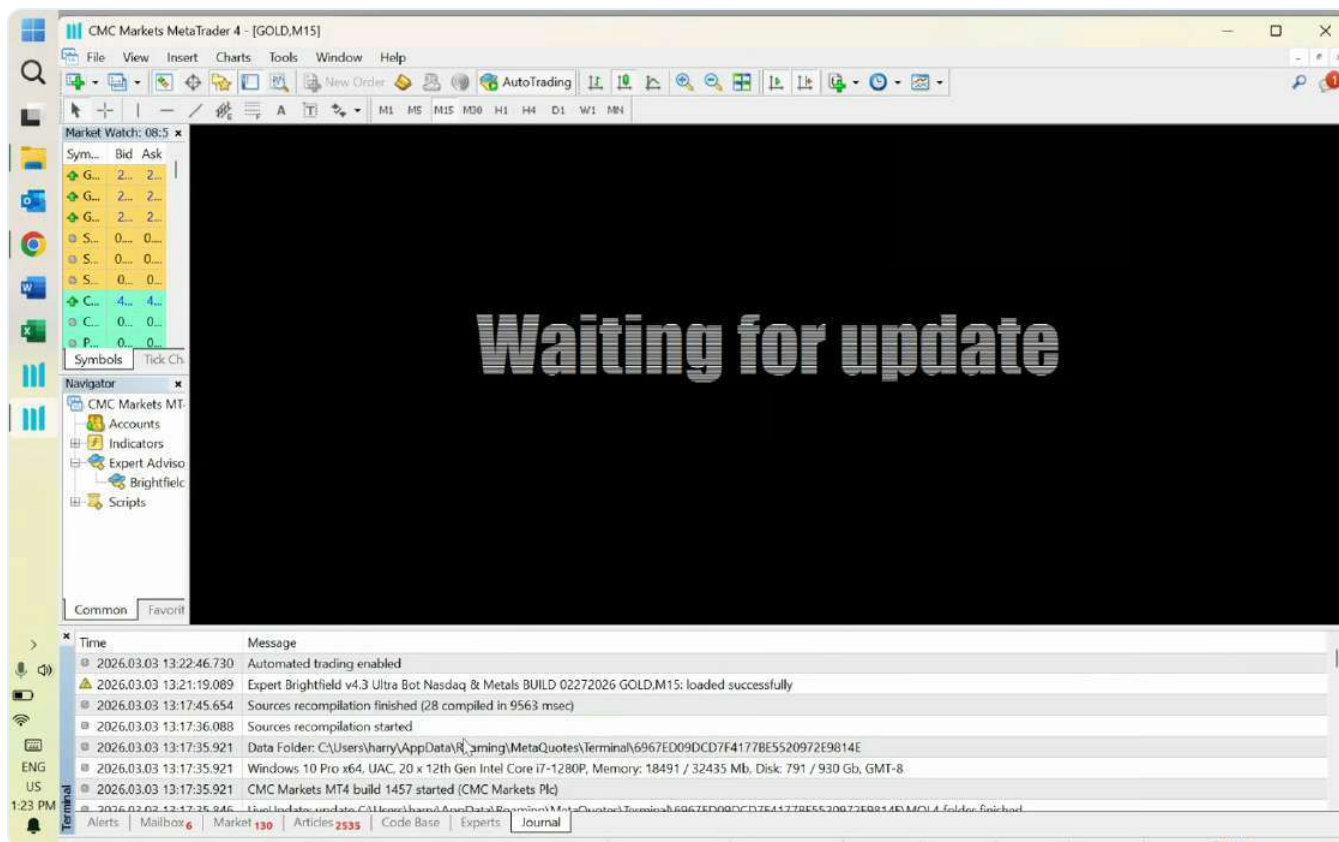
43 Under Common, make sure Allow Live Trading is selected

Ensure live trading is enabled for the bot.



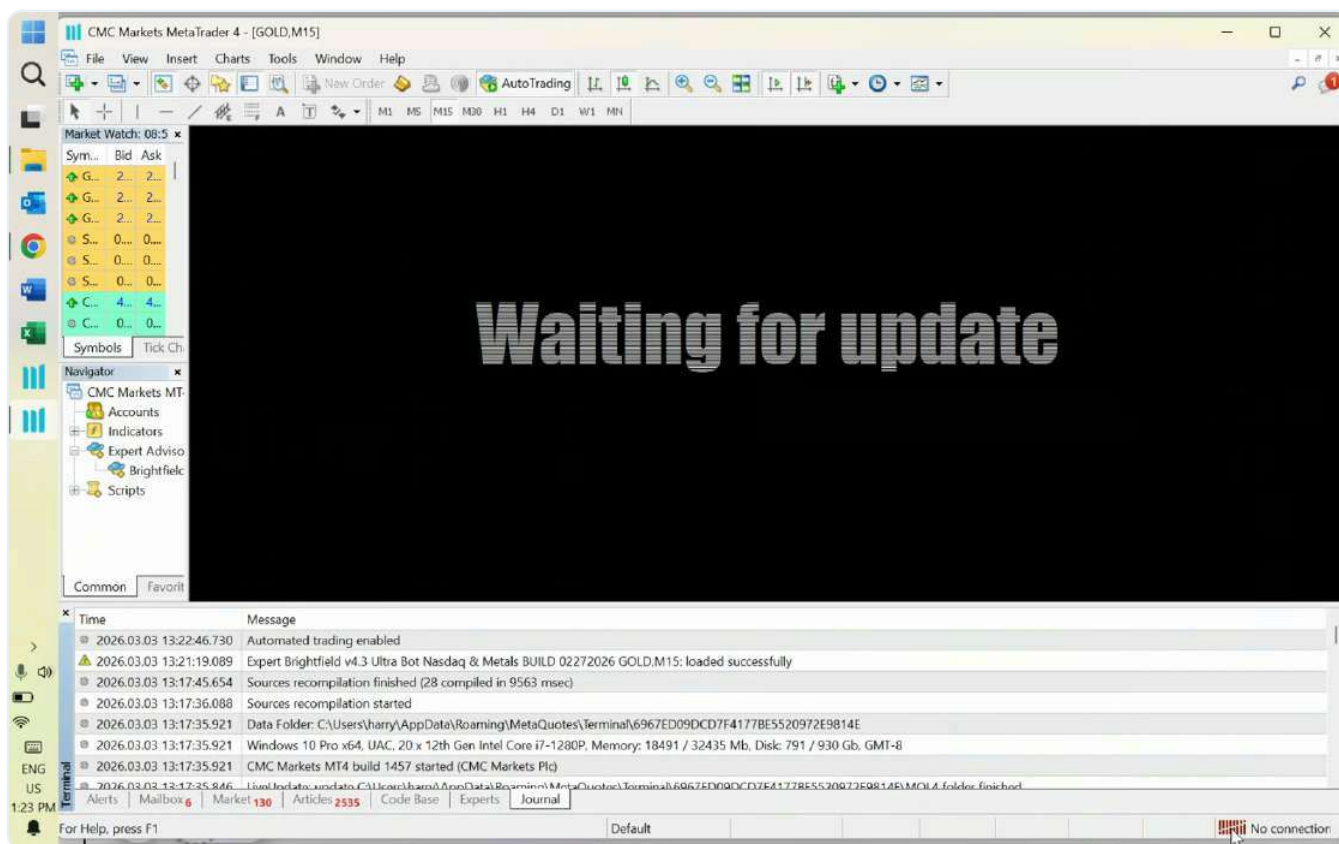
44 Check the Journal in the terminal for login status if the bot is not working

The journal will show errors or connection issues.



45 Check the connection status for red bars indicating no connection

Red bars mean you are not connected to the broker.



46 Once you see a chart with a happy face, trading is occurring live

This confirms your bot is running and trading live.
